1 - TAILOR-MADE PROGRAMS

The International Relations Office delivers tailor-made programs in English in diverse areas, including Chilean Culture, Doing Business in Latin-America, Education, Humanities, Law, Engineering, among others.

For students majoring in Spanish, we offer customized programs in Spanish in all levels, including Spanish for Health practitioners, Chilean identity and others, both for undergraduate and graduate level students.

Programs can be delivered during the whole year (excluding February) and students receive academic credits from Universidad de los Andes. We develop Faculty-led programs combining UANDES and visiting Professors or completely taught by UANDES. The programs are mainly delivered in our Campus and include guest speakers and off-campus lectures.

2- GO UANDES - GLOBAL OPPORTUNITIES

ONGOING PROGRAMS

The Global Opportunities programs at UANDES offer both incoming and UANDES students the chance to meet international peers in a great academic environment. The GO UANDES programs aim to get together students from different countries and learn actively through various methods as classes, field trips, joint projects, among others.

These are intensive and real life-changing experiences, where international students learn from local faculty and students and for them it is a great opportunity to experience their own country with foreign eyes and practice their English.

The International Relations coordinates these programs which are completely delivered in English, so students and Faculty without the language knowledge can participate.

GO LEADERSHIP Chilean & Latin American Politics

2, 3 or 4-week program in January
2 weeks / 40 contact hours / 3 US - 6 ECTS credits
3 weeks / 60 contact hours / 4 US - 8 ECTS credits
4 weeks / 80 contact hours / 5 US - 10 ECTS credits

Program with lectures, activities and field trips regarding Chilean and Latin American economy and entrepreneurship, political leadership and cultural aspects. It includes sessions of Spanish as a Foreign Language.

GO SPANISH@UANDES Intensive Spanish & Chilean Culture

4-week program in July
90 contact hours / 4 US - 8 ECTS credits

Intensive Spanish Language Courses that includes an insight into the Chilean and Latin American culture. We can offer the levels A1, B1 and B2, if the minimum of students per course is achieved.

GO CHILEAN ECONOMY Another view of Chilean Economy: History and future challenges

3-week program in July - August
60 contact hours / 6 US - 12 ECTS credits

Intensive and interactive program with classes and activities that offer an insight of Chilean Economy. It includes sessions of Spanish as a Foreign Language.

*For our partner institutions the tuition fee is waived as the program is part of the reciprocity exchange scheme.

*Non-partner institutions students pay fees for application, program and tuition.
